1.0 PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, Part VII Transitional Provisions of the Liberia Revenue Authority (LRA) Act of 2013, Section 38(1), Repeals and consequential Amendments transferred the administrative and operational powers and duties the code assigns to the Minister or Deputy Minister to the Commissioner General;

WHEREAS, the LRA Act of 2013, Section 21(1) (a) & (b) provides, in relevant parts, that the Commissioner General shall be responsible for the administration and supervision of the code. The Commissioner General shall also:

- (a) Ensure the effective and fair interpretation, application and implementation of the Code,
- (b) Ensure the proper and diligent implementation of this Act;

WHEREAS, the general authorization provision of Section 8(1) of the LRA Act of 2013 states that, "the authority is authorized to discharge its functions under this act and has the power to take necessary action to accomplish those functions in the manner and using the methods permitted under the code and other laws";

WHEREAS, a Primary Function of the LRA pursuant to section 7(1) of the LRA Act of 2013 is to transparently, equitably and fairly administer collection of national revenues and to ensure the deposit of all amounts assessed and collected into the Consolidated Fund; and

WHEREAS, Section 101 (b) and (c) of the Modernized Customs Code of 2018 empowers the Commissioner General and Commissioner of Customs to grant an application for authorization to transmit and keep forms by means of an electronic record

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with law, the LRA herewith sets forth procedures for the authorization by the Commissioner of Customs and the Commissioner General to transmit and keep forms by means of an electronic record consistent with Section 101 of the Modernized Customs Code of 2018.

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2.0 LEGAL BASIS

This Regulation is pursuant to Sub-sections 101 (b) and (c) of the Modernized Customs Code of 2018, which states that,

(b) An application for authorization to transmit and keep forms by means of an electronic record shall be granted in writing by

 The Commissioner for Customs, with respect to an application related to records required under part V of this Code, or

(2) The Commissioner General, with respect to an application related to records required under this Act other than those required by Part V,

if the Commissioner for Customs or the Commissioner General, respectively, is satisfied that the applicant meets the prescribed eligibility criteria.

(c) The Commissioner General shall by regulation prescribe such measures as required to implement this Section including the form, manner, and content of the application referenced in subsection (b)

3.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Administrative Regulation is to outline procedures for the authorization by the Commissioner of Customs and the Commissioner General to transmit and keep forms by means of an electronic record consistent with Section 101 (b) and (c) of the Modernized Customs Code of 2018.

4.0 PROCEDURE

- (a) An application to the Commissioner for Customs or the Commissioner General for authorization to transmit forms and information by means of an electronic record must be made in the form set out in Annex 004 to this regulation for the Customs electronic processing system concerned.
- (b) The application for authorization under paragraph 4.1 shall be accompanied by the completed system user agreement set out in Annex 004 of this Regulation.
- (c) The application for authorization under Paragraph 4.1 and system user agreement under Paragraph 4.2 shall be signed by the applicant. Where the applicant is a legal entity, the application for authorization and system user agreement shall be signed by a duly authorized officer, director or employee who shall provide evidence of such authorization if required by the Commissioner for Customs or Commissioner General.



5.0 PUBLIC NOTICE

The Government of Liberia, through the Liberia Revenue Authority, hereby announces the procedures for the authorization by the Commissioner of Customs and the Commissioner General to transmit and keep forms by means of an electronic record consistent with Section 101 (b) and (c) of the Modernized Customs Code of 2018.

6.0 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Administrative Regulation shall take effect as of 30 APR, 2021.
